To: Plan Members and Contributing Employers

We are pleased to present our Annual Report which outlines the activities of the Fund during the fiscal period ending August 31, 2019.

Participation in training remains robust in the Edmonton Training Centre with 1,859 plan members taking 29,208 hours of training. In the Calgary Training Centre, 542 plan members partook in 8,120 hours of training.

The average no show/attendance problem rate for the Edmonton Training Centre decreased from 2.6% to 2.3%. The rate at the Calgary Training Centre decreased from 3.9% to 2.7%.

Over the last year the Edmonton Training Centre was able to accommodate 2 Trade Winds sessions, consisting of a total of 15 students.

The Investment Committee has monitored the investments of the Fund, utilizing advice from investment consultants.

The Board of Trustees approved the following:

- The adoption of an amended Fitness for Duty and Substance Abuse Policy.
- The Edmonton Training Centre becoming a test facility for the Photovoltaic Systems Personal Certification.
- Continuing with the PACT Program contingent on labour market needs.
- Ongoing new courses arising from contractor and industry needs.
